If you could not answer TRUE, you are not alone. Between 70-90% of churches in the Southern Baptist Convention and in the Southside Baptist Network are either plateaued or declining, finding themselves in need of assistance. Many churches have lost or are losing their vitality.

We recognize this need and have formed the Church Revitalization Team (CRT). It is the mission of the CRT to assist churches by working through a structured process to help them identify realistic solutions. The CRT works to help churches transform into a vital "Body of Christ" that is effective in advancing the Gospel and developing disciples.

Church Revitalization Team Approach

Each Church is recognized as a local, autonomous congregation. The CRT comes alongside existing church leadership to honestly assess the church's spiritual and organizational health through a structured process of discovery and exploration, listening and feedback sessions, and in-depth congregational surveys.

The CRT will provide leadership for the formulation of specific recommendations that will be presented to the church staff and ministry leaders, congregational leaders, and then the entire church body.

The church will be asked to officially and formally affirm the recommendations. The partnership between the local congregation and the CRT will continue only with an affirmative vote. If a church chooses not to affirm the recommendations, the Church Revitalization Team will exit the process so the church can seek other support resources, if it so chooses.
